## SUNY Utica/Rome Earns Yahoo's 'Most Wired Colleges' List

The Institute of Technology has been named among the "100 Most Wired Colleges" by *Yahoo! Internet Life* magazine.

In the magazine's third annual ranking of the college's that have made the most of technology, published this past April, the Institute of Technology is among America's elite schools.

Although unranked previously, SUNY Utica/Rome was rated 95th among more than 3,600 college and universities in the nation. The 100 Most Wired Colleges list was based on four criteria: hardware, academics, free services, and miscellaneous services, such as Web re-

strictions, electronic applications, seeing-disabled services and ergonomic keyboards.

Ronald Sarner, Ph.D., director of information services at the college and a distinguished service professor, said the ranking places the college in rare company academically and technologically. "This also sends a very clear message to current and prospective students that the Institute of Technology is committed to serving the college community and will put human and financial resources behind that commitment." Sarner also pointed out that for every one of the 584 beds in the residence halls there is a network computer connection and 60 percent of the residential students have signed up for this free service. He said the college is proud to be listed among colleges and universities such as Harvard, Princeton and MIT.

SUNY Utica/Rome was also the first college within the State University to allow full web registration and has been a leader in academic uses of technology. For example, the college broke ground with an international distance learning project in 1995 when seven students from the Moscow Institute of Electronics and Mathematics earned their master's degrees from SUNY Utica/Rome.



This fall, SUNY Utica/Rome will offer approximately 20 online courses and the college's Continuing Professional Education department currently offers 55 online courses.

The college also has an online master of science degree in accountancy through the SUNY Learning Network. That online

system was also named by *Yahoo! Internet Life* as among one of the top two online distance learning networks in the country.

The State University of New York placed two other colleges on the magazine's list, the University at Buffalo, which ranked No. 47, and SUNY Geneseo, No. 49.

# SUNY Utica/Rome Graduates Protect and Serve Students

SUNY Institute of Technology at Utica/Rome is proud that our campus was voted No. 1 in safety. This distinction comes as a result of a great deal of work on the part of the college's University Police office. Malcolm (Bud) Harris '82, chief of university police is proud of the No. 1 ranking from the SUNY student survey. Harris graduated from the criminal justice program in 1982 as a result of an opportunity under a federal program that encouraged police officers to return to college and continue their education.

Harris began his career with SUNY Morrisville in 1971. He began as an officer and worked his way up the ranks. He joined SUNY Utica/Rome in 1982 as the director of public safety. Harris reminisces about the difficulty of patrolling the different campuses at that time. "We had Potter Center, Mill Square and Court Street as well as a building in Rome, N.Y." Public Safety was provided at all buildings at all times.

The University Police office has had many names over the years. When Harris began his career at SUNY Morrisville, the office was called the security office. The name was then changed to Public Safety and then on Jan. 1, 1999, the office was renamed University Police.

Harris said the law grants State University officers the same powers and status as other police officers in the state. Campus officers will be legally allowed to pursue criminal investigations off-campus and assist local police forces.

According to Harris, all officers must complete a 16-week program at the State Police Academy on administration of justice, basic law, campus police procedures, firearms, defensive tactics, criminal investigations, special patrol topics and human relations in a campus setting. Each graduate has a minimum of 60 hours of college credits and is required to pass a civil service examination and a background check, medical and physical agility examinations and a psychological examination.

Harris attended classes with other criminal justice students who also serve in the law enforcement field. Among them: Mark Fairbrother '78, environmental health and safety inspector at SUNY Utica/Rome; Gregory Walsh '85, lieutenant with the New York State Police; Walsh's wife Jill was also affiliated with the New York State Police; Michael Corpin '77, chief of police at SUNY Morrisville, Pete Lalla '80, chief of police at SUNY Cortland, Gary Bean '77, director of security at Colgate University, and Steve Rys, lieutenant with the University Police at SUNY Utica/Rome.

## Ledda Makes Big Splash in Hollywood

SUNY Utica/Rome has added a little bit of Hollywood to its advertising efforts and an alumnus is center stage, literally.

Jeff Ledda, who earned a bachelor of science degree in electrical engineering technology in 1987, was shown in the advertisement standing in front of the deep dive vessel that assisted Titanic director James Cameron during the filming of that Academy-Award winning film. Titanic set box office records and won 11 Academy Awards, including an Oscar for cinematography. Ledda's design of the underwater remote operated vehicle played a critical part in the deep sea filming of Titanic.

In the cinema advertisement, Ledda is quoted, "SUNY Utica/Rome helped take me to new depths."

The college's marketing committee placed cinema advertising on screens in four locations in Utica, Syracuse and Albany beginning May 21 and coinciding with the debut of the latest movie in the Star Wars series, "The Phantom Menace." The cinema ads were projected prior to movies shown at the Carousel Center in Syracuse, the Riverside Center in Utica, Sangertown Square in New Hartford, and Crossgates Mall in Albany. The ads were shown several times prior to movies being viewed by tens of thousands of moviegoers in those regions. Typically, late spring and early summer are heavy attendance periods for cinemas and this season's figures were especially high based on the aggressive marketing of "The Phantom Menace" and the second Austin Powers film, "The Spy Who Shagged Me;" those two productions were top-rated throughout the 12-week period during which the SUNY Utica/Rome advertisements were on screen.

The marketing committee is planning to expand the college's presence, partly through cinema ads, in the Albany area. Throughout the past several advertising campaigns, SUNY Utica/Rome alumni have been shown and heard providing comments regarding their experiences at the college and how their degree has helped them launch successful careers.

## Finance Professor Assumes Dean's Position

Sanjay B. Varshney, Ph. D, CFA, has been named interim dean of the School of Management. He replaces Richard Havranek, Ph. D., who stepped down to devote more time to his teaching assignments at SUNY Utica/Rome (see related story on page 5). Dr. Varshney began his duties as interim dean in the spring semester.

Dr. Varshney has been with the college as an assistant professor of finance and has been one of the college's most active and enterprising faculty members. Last year, he and fellow professor Edward Petronio co-hosted a television show called "The World of Finance," a program that was aimed at helping individual investors. The popular show was aired on Utica-area cable channel 34 and featured a call-in format and professional advice from the two SUNY Utica/Rome professors.

Internationally known through his published works in top-tier financial journals, Dr. Varshney holds the prestigious designation of chartered financial analyst. He has served as financial consultant for leading Wall Street firms and has trained top executives in San Francisco. His work is also included in a textbook for doctoral students and he has won both national and international awards for his research expertise.

Dr. Varshney teaches finance and manages portfolios for individuals, trusts, pensions, and corporations through his investment management firm.

Dr. Varshney received his bachelor's in accounting, a master's in economics from the University of Cincinnati, and a doctorate in finance from Louisiana State University. He has previously taught at the University of San Francisco. He is affiliated with the New York Society of Security Analysts, the Rochester Society of Security Analysts, Association for Investment Management & Research, and Financial Management Association International.

Those students will receive a full credit transfer.

In addition, students who complete the SUNY Utica/Rome bachelor's degree may apply for entry into a master of science degree program in accountancy or business management, with concentrations in management accounting, finance, health services management, human resource management, and management science. A full-time student could complete both the bachelor's and master's degree programs in three years after completing studies at MVCC.

MVCC Associate Professor Catherine Glod, head of the college's business/management systems department, said, "We are very excited about this agreement. It will reduce admissions paperwork for our students, and clarify the transfer of MVCC credit to SUNY Utica/Rome. It also enables students to maximize the educational resources represented by two fine institutions working cooperatively."

The joint MVCC/SUNY Utica/Rome admissions opportunity is open to student who enroll at MVCC in accounting, banking and insurance, business management, computer information systems, office technologies, and individual studies.

The office technologies curriculum includes executive, legal, information processing, and medical concentrations. In MVCC's business management program, students may select courses to create a specialization in marketing, human resources, international business, computer information systems, and retail.

Some 400 Institute of Technology students joined the ranks of alumni as they received bachelor's or master's degrees at the college's 25th annual commencement on May 8 at the Utica Memorial Auditorium. During the college's December 1998 commencement, another 400 students received their degrees.

The Rev. Theodore M. Hesburgh, who led the University of Notre Dame for 35 years, addressed the graduates. Father Hesburgh was awarded an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree from the State University of New York. Also honored at the ceremony was State Senator Ray Meier (R-47th Dist.) who was presented with the Institute of Technology's Distinguished Service Award.

Father Hesburgh, 81, has been awarded 140 honorary degrees, by far the most bestowed on any individual (President Herbert Hoover received 89 honorary degrees, the second most awarded). The awarding of the honorary doctorate at the Institute of Technology is the first such recognition of Father Hesburgh, a Syracuse native, by any State University of New York college.

Father Hesburgh retired as president of Notre Dame in 1987, ending the longest tenure at that time among active presidents of American institutions of higher learning. He

took a one-year sabbatical and then returned to an office at the Hesburgh Library to begin writing his autobiography, "God, Country, Notre Dame," which was published in 1990 and became a national bestseller. Father Hesburgh has since written two more books, "Travels with Ned and Ted" and "The Challenge and Promise of a Catholic University."

He continues his activities at the university and as a representative of Notre Dame to national and international organizations. He maintains an office at Notre Dame in the new 14-story Father Hesburgh Library.

### Distinguished Service Award

State Senator Meier was honored for his dynamic leadership for the constituents of the 47th State Senatorial District and, specifically, for his efforts on behalf of public higher education and the Institute of Technology.

During his two terms as a member of the New York State Senate and his six years as Oneida County Executive, Senator Meier has led the charge to make public higher education a priority and has lobbied on behalf of students to the State University Board of Trustees, the State Education Department, the State Legislature and the governor.

According to Institute of Technology President Peter J. Cayan, "The senator has operated tirelessly to provide educational and em-

ployment opportunities for the residents of the 47th State Senatorial District. In doing so, he has been true to his belief that an excellent education and a good job also provide individuals with freedom and independence. In his steadfast support of the college's mission and proposed curricular expansion, the senator has added his creative talents and offered his professional expertise to that process."

President Cayan stressed that Senator Meier, as a member of the Senate Higher Education Committee, has been "a consistent voice of reason and a powerful friend."
