D	A graduate student whose first enrollment as a graduate student at the reporting institution occurs during the current term AND is charged the orientation fee.
E	A student enrolled at an international college coming to SUNY to participate in one of SUNY's approved overseas Exchange Programs.
F	A student who has not attended any college or university after completing/terminating his high school education and is enrolling at the reporting institution for the first time in the current term.
G	A graduate student whose first enrollment as a graduate student at the reporting institution occurs during the current term AND is in an <b>accelerated</b> program (e.g. BS/MS) AND is NOT charged the orientation fee.
н	A student that is simultaneously enrolled in high school and college before completing/terminating his or her high school education. A concurrently enrolled student should be classified as a first-time student in the fall/spring immediately following the completion/termination of his or her high school education.
Р	A graduate student whose first enrollment as a graduate student at the reporting institution occurs during the current term AND is charged the orientation fee AND is seeking a PhD. NOTE: SIRIS maps to D. Can only be P their first semester, then becomes continuing student.
S	A cooperative arrangement between colleges that allows a student to receive instruction and obtain academic credit for courses administered by an institution other than the student's home institution.
z	A new graduate student that has taken a course(s) in the summer prior to the fall entering cohort. Note: Can only be a student type of Z during the summer term, then becomes a D the following fall.
Q	New student type code. A current MS student that is new to the PhD program. Note: SIRIS maps to student type B=continuing student.
